

intacs™ certified ISO/IEC 15504 Competent Assessor

In the automotive industry ISO/IEC 15504 has become a mandatory standard and ticket-to-trade. Given increased competitive conditions companies are introducing process improvement projects as a means to increase efficiency and quality in development. Since August 2005 Automotive SPICE® is available as an ISO 15504 conform assessment model adapted to the requirements of the automotive industry, expected increasingly of suppliers.

This five-day course builds on the experiences gained by the participants as intacs™ Provisional Assessors. Before the course participants will receive appropriate materials to prepare and equalize their experiences.

Objectives

This five day course offers participants:

- an intacs™ certified ISO 15504 (SPICE) Assessor qualification
- the capability to plan, lead and document recognized process evaluations in accordance with Automotive SPICE®
- a deeper understanding of the process dimension and the capability dimension, i.e. a deeper understanding of important aspects and problems, e.g. the relationships between processes, traceability, mapping real integration and test processes onto the Automotive SPICE® model, the operating environment, "What is CM of the CM process?", "PM of the PM process?", etc.
- a deeper understanding of topics like e.g.: concepts and requirements of capability levels 4 and 5; planning and leading an assessment; practical tips; how to deal with extreme situations in assessments; assessments on several sites, and international assessments; coaching of Provisional Assessors; team management.

Attendees and Prerequisites

Number of Participants: up to 10 people approx.

The course is aimed at experienced assessors who met the relevant intacs™ requirements 12 months after the previous course as the latest (cf. intacs™ requirements Feb. 2010), including the performance of 5 assessments with 250 assessment hours and a recommendation by a Competent or Principal Assessor.

- in case of successful participation in the written examination: an intacs™ certified 'ISO 15504 Competent Assessor' certificate
