

Automotive SPICE® for Managers

In the automotive industry ISO/IEC 15504 has become a mandatory standard and ticket-to-trade. Given increased competitive conditions companies are introducing process improvement projects as a means to increase efficiency and quality in development. Automotive SPICE® is available as an ISO 15504 conform assessment model adapted to the requirements of the automotive industry.

This one-day course imparts a sound understanding of the architecture and principles of the ISO/IEC 15504 standard called SPICE (Software Process Improvement and Capability dEtermination) as well as Automotive. The contents of the Process Assessment Models are not treated in detail.

Course Objectives

This two day course imparts

- a good understanding of the architecture and principles of ISO/IEC 15504 and Automotive SPICE®
- what the so-called 'HIS Scope' is (i.e. the minimum range of Automotive SPICE® requirements checked in particular by German OEMs with their suppliers)
- an understanding how an assessment is performed and how to prepare for an OEM assessment
